



Quinta do Judeu Reserva Red

Quinta do Judeu top red wine comes from Quinta do Judeu Covelinhas old vines (60 years old) and Quinta do Judeu Corgo Touriga Nacional. The structure of the wines from the hotter Cima Corgo sub-region blended with the freshness and acidity from the cooler Baixo Corgo area, allows the Douro to express its terroir with balance, complexity, elegance and ageing capacity.

Grape Varieties

More than 15 different Douro native varieties from old vineyards from Quinta do Judeu Covelinhas (Cima Corgo sub-region), with the predominance of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Barroca, Tinto Cão, Tinta Amarela, Tinta Francisca and Sousão.

Vinification

Pre-selected grapes carried to cellar in 20kg boxes and trodden by foot in traditional granite tanks (lagares) with automatic temperature control.
